Publications

The Publications subcommittee has absorbed the Communications subcommittee so both groups' leadership can better serve the committee's membership.

The Publications subcommittee will produce content for the Cannabis committee's monthly e-newsletter launching in January 2020 within the CLM Magazine. Cannabis eNews should seek to provide relevant regulatory and legislative updates, practical skills, and innovative strategies for effectively handling claims and litigation related to the emerging cannabis market for the benefit of CLM's readership (claims, risk, and litigation professionals). Each column should demonstrate the expertise and opinions of the authors in a way that helps educate and inform like-minded professionals on how they can do their jobs better and stay up to date on a rapidly changing market.

Requirements:

- Columns should be between 500-1,100 words long and single-spaced in Word. No footnotes/end notes, and case citations should be limited to just the case name.
- Each column should contain a suggested headline as well as a byline for the author. An example of an acceptable byline includes:

- All columns should (but are not required to) be co-written by one CLM member (outside counsel) and one CLM fellow (industry/vendor rep).
- Both authors must be a current Fellow or Member of CLM.
